- Tuesday, March 3, 2026 - 9 a.m. to noon; 5 to 6:30 p.m.
- Wednesday, March 4 - 9 a.m. to noon
- Thursday, March 5 - 9 a.m. to noon; 5 to 6:30 p.m.
- Friday, March 6 - 9 a.m. to noon

Qualifying will be held at [St. Julian's Episcopal Church](#) in Douglasville.

To qualify, make a check, cashier's check or money order payable to the Douglas County Democratic Committee; qualifying fees will be shared with the Douglas County Board of Elections and Registration.
